

However even in China, he wasn't able to find food, and his family was all scattered.






His wife left the house to find food but never returned, and his children followed their grandfather to China to live.





After defecting, Jung Yong-chul came to know the reality of the Kim Il-sung ideology.

Praising God has the power to change a person.






However, to Jung Yong-chul, separation from his family had left a deep scar.

How dare you!! Don't you fool around with this!


He was furious; he thought he was joking around.




Ha-min's body was in a very bad state.




God answered his prayers for his family, and he became more committed to the work of the ministry.

God save us.. God save us..


In the prison, there was an engraved sentence which Jin Calvin and Park Yo-han, the first graduating class of the ministry, had written when they were caught.


When seeing this, Jung Yongchul regained his courage and entrusted everything to God, including his life.
